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Grade 4, 5, and 6 Soccer Rules and Expectations 2021/2022

(created with student input)

Expectations:

- At the start of recess, students will line up and supervisor will pick the teams equally and randomly
- 2. Grades of students will play together (4's with the 4's)
- 3. Players will not show aggression while playing towards other students
- 4. If a supervisor asks a student(s) to leave the game- they are expected to do so respectfully
- 5. Supervisors will pick the goalie at the start of the game
- 6. With each recess, a new game starts, with new teams and goalies
- 7. It is expected that students follow the rules of Penhold Elementary School, and the Panther 5.
- 8. We will use a 3 strike rule- if they are asked to leave the game for aggression, or foul language or not following the rules, they will receive a strike. Strikes are recorded by PES staff through the office.

Rules:

- 1. Body contact during play is not allowed
- 2. Side tackling is not allowed
- 3. Language must remain positive-foul language will result in a strike
- 4. Players cannot touch the ball with their hands
- 5. All players must stay 1 meter from the goalie at all times
- 6. No arguing with other students or adults
- 7. Students need to pass the ball equally

If students are not following the rules and expectations, they will receive a strike. After 3 strikes, the student will no longer be allowed to play soccer for one month. After one month away from soccer and good behaviour displayed during recess times, the student's homeroom teacher will inform him/her if he/she is able to return to playing. If students are welcome back to play soccer, the same rules will be applied. Having students follow the rules and expectations helps make the game of soccer fun and enjoyable for all students no matter their skill level.
