Penhold Elementary School Ski Days at Canyon Ski Hill!

Parents/Guardians of Penhold Elementary School,

We are very happy to be offering our students the opportunity to participate in skiing or snowboarding at Canyon Ski Hill in the first part of the New Year. This is always such a fun day for students, staff, and volunteers to get outside, get some exercise, and enjoy each other's company! The ski dates are **February 15th and March 1st.** This is a wonderful opportunity for your child to try it out for the first time or to get another day of practice for those who are more experienced.

Below is the estimated cost for attending only one of the days or both days. If your child has their own gear but no helmet, they will need to rent one once they are at the hill. <u>All outstanding school fees need to be paid before a student can participate in the skiing days, this includes CTF fees and Agenda fees.</u>

Type of Package	One Day	Both Days
Lift ticket, equipment rental, lesson, bussing	\$60	\$120
Lift ticket. Lesson, bussing	\$35	\$70
Lesson (you are a season ticket holder), bussing	\$25	\$50

You will received an email today with a **Letter of Intent** form attached. This is to be filled out and submitted so that we can get an idea of how many students will be skiing or snowboarding, which days, and who will be staying back at the school. The form is due back by **December 1st**. Students who choose not to go to Canyon, will be participating in some fun learning in the classroom, in the gymnasium, and maybe even outside!
